shows you **HOW-TO** No Sew **Fleece Scarf**

Supplies:

- 1/4 yard of fleece fabric
- Ruler
- Scissors or rotary cutter and mat
- Tape
- Pony beads

Directions:

1. Cut fleece to 7" wide and trim off salvage edges. (Make scarves for kids about 54" long and adults about 63" long)
2. Fold scarf with ends together.
3. Measure 4" up from bottom of scarf edges and mark this line with a piece of tape going across entire width of scarf.
4. Measure and mark 1/4" segments across tapeline and across bottom of scarf. Cut 1/4" lines from bottom of scarf to tape line.
5. Thread 3 or more pony beads on the fringe using a toothpick or opened paperclip to push fleece thru. Tie a knot near the end.
